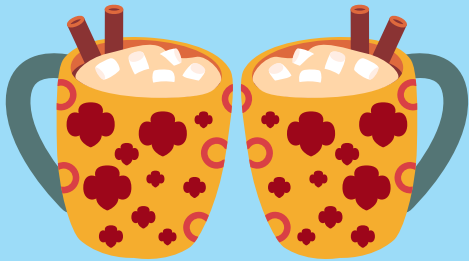

How does it work?

Groups of Girl Scouts, called troops, typically meet weekly or bi-weekly for an hour or two. Together with adult volunteers—often parents or caregivers—girls select exciting hands-on activities and projects, try new things, and cheer each other on. Together, they earn badges to reflect their successes and show the world what they're made of.
