A "borrow pit" is an area where soil, gravel or sand is dug up to be used at another location. Because Windsor Elementary is a "net cut" site, it is serving as the borrow pit for Eagle Point (a "net fill" site). In the next few weeks, dump trucks will be running between Windsor and Eagle Point to transport this material.
