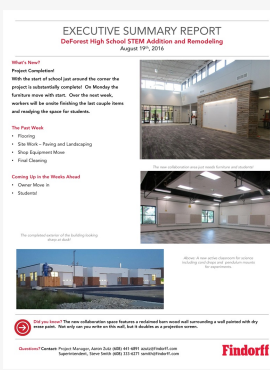
#### **DeForest Area High School STEM**

August 19th update from Findorff Project Manager Aaron Zutz

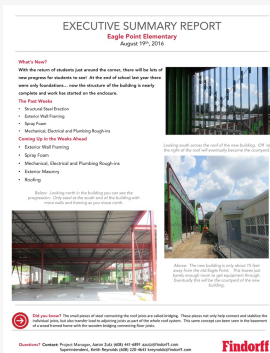

## "Did you know?"

The small pieces of steel connecting the roof joists are called bridging. These pieces not only help connect and stabilize the individual joists, but also transfer load to adjoining joists as part of the whole roof system. This same concept can be seen in the basement of a wood framed home with the wooden bridging connecting floor joists.
