Below are updates for DeForest Area High School, Eagle Point Elementary School and Windsor Elementary School as we move through the phases of construction and grand openings!



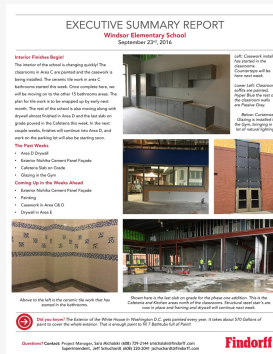
DeForest Area High School
