You're invited to take part in providing key upfront input in the development of the Village's 5-year Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. The workshop and survey are free and open to the public.

WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE OUTDOOR RECREATION PLAN?

The Village is currently working on its 5-year update of the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. The purpose of the Plan is to identify and prioritize the Village's existing facilities, assets, and areas of needed improvement, in addition to future park and recreation needs. The document also contains topic-specific goals, objectives, policies, and recommendations, as well as a community-wide vision and action plan to help prioritize future implementation projects. By completing this plan every 5 years, DeForest retains eligibility through the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to apply for matching state and federal grants.

Whether you live, work, play, or own property in the Village of DeForest, now is your chance to participate in shaping the future of the community.
