What's New?

We are well under way on construction at both the middle school STEM and Yahara Elementary projects. Demolition of both spaces are complete and subcontractors are working on putting the spaces back together. At Yahara Elementary we are just a few weeks away from being complete with the finishes just starting out now. At the Middle School we are working to get everything roughed-in so that the painter can start on the ceilings the first week of August.

The Past Week

- Yahara Elementary
 - All MEP rough-ins are complete.
 - Installed drywall and started finishing it to be ready for painting
- MS STEM
 - All demolition is complete
 - MEP subs have started to install their rough-ins including the new dust collection system.

Coming Up in the Week Ahead

- Yahara Elementary
 - Continue with finishes, painting, ceilings, flooring and casework
- MS STEM
 - Start painting the ceiling and all walls
