School Meals

What you need to know

Q: Are school meals free for all students for the current school year?

A: No, meals will be full price for all students. Families who believe they may qualify for free or reduced meals should complete an application available online via Skyward Family Access. Students will need money in lunch accounts beginning the first day of school unless they have received a letter from DASD stating that they have been approved for free meals for the 2024-25 school year.

Q: How can I get Free or Reduced priced meals for my child/children? Will I need to complete an application for the current school year?

A: Yes, you will need to complete an application. All students will be considered full price in the 2024-25 school year until a completed application is received and approved by DASD.

Q: Are there other benefits I might be eligible to receive?

A: Yes, you will need to complete an application. All students will be considered full price in the 2024-25 school year until a completed application is received and approved by DASD.
