DeForest Area School District Board of Education Meeting Minutes Monday, February 10, 2020 – 6:00 pm.

1. Convene

President Jan Berg called the February 10, 2020 regular meeting of the DeForest Area School District's Board of Education to order at 6:00 p.m.

Eric Runez verified that the meeting was properly noticed.

 - A. Report on upcoming engagement opportunities Debbie Brewster, School/Community Relations Coordinator

<u>Discussion</u>: School/Community Relations Coordinator, Debbie Brewster announced that the annual Parent Survey would be distributed next week. All parents will be surveyed and asked to take the survey for each school in which they have children attending. Brewster asks the Board to help promote the survey. At the end of February, parents will also be given an opportunity to provide feedback on parent-teacher conferences. The naming of the Intermediate School survey will be ending on Wednesday and results will be presented to the Board at the February 24, 2020 Board meeting. Brewster also explained the importance of completing the upcoming 2020 U.S. Census.

The Visioning Team for the project identified three vision statements that include serving students, families, and community; elevating trust; and fostering collaboration.
