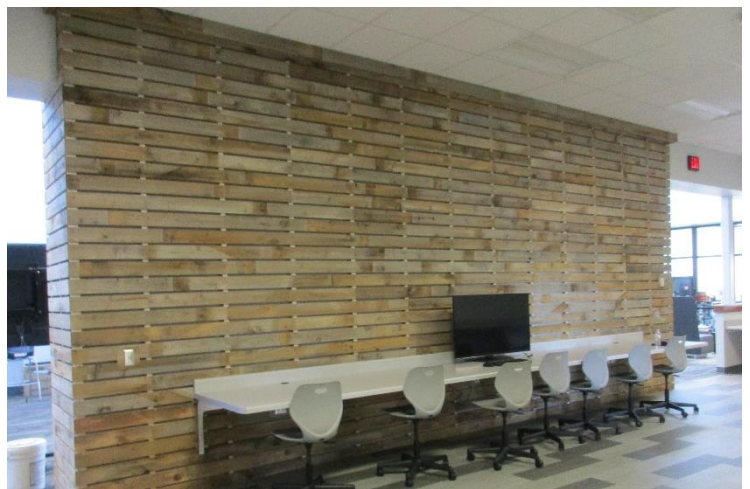
Classes are now in session, and students and teachers will be able to enjoy an outstanding learning environment for years to come!
