### Attendance Matters



Although there are many challenges to student attendance, we want to encourage our families to do all they can to promote consistent and punctual school attendance. **Our school day begins in the classroom at 7:40 am.** This means students will **need to arrive by 7:30 am** to put their personal belongings away and be seated in the classroom prior to 7:40 am. Students wanting to get a school breakfast may arrive by 7:20 am.

**Students not in their seats and ready to learn by 7:40 am will be marked tardy.**

Attending school regularly, and on time, helps children feel better about school and themselves. Start building this habit in elementary school, so they learn right away that going to school on time every day is important. Good attendance will be a habit that will help students succeed in their future education.

#### How You Can Help

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Have a back up plan for getting your child to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbor, or another parent.
- Try to schedule appointments and other planned activities for when school is not in session.
- Talk to your child about any anxieties they may have. Reach out to teachers, our school social worker, our school counselor or other parents for advice on helping your child feel excited and comfortable about going to school.

## Eclipse - April 8th - Message from the Principal



As you may know, there will be a partial solar eclipse visible in our area on April 8, 2024. While this is an exciting astronomical event, we have decided that students will not view the eclipse at school with eclipse glasses. Viewing a solar eclipse without proper eye protection can potentially cause permanent eye damage and vision loss. To safely view an eclipse, special eclipse glasses or other certified sun filters are required. With hundreds of students, we cannot ensure that every child would have the approved eye protection and use it properly throughout the entire eclipse.

We will have standard reminders that we will teach our students regarding sun safety. While we recognize that the solar eclipse may spark scientific interest, we will let classroom teachers determine what they may wish to have their classes learn about eclipses through classroom lessons and materials.
