The Administration, under the direction of the Director of Administrative Services, shall develop a district disaster plan to provide guidance should an emergency situation arise at school or in the community. Emergency plans will serve as preparedness measures, as well as educational tools by imparting basic fundamentals for student safety.

Therefore, the Director of Administrative Services will work in cooperation with the building principals and appropriate governmental and community agencies to design, implement, and review all emergency plans. Adequate instruction and implementation drills must take place at all levels to assure order and efficiency in the event of a true emergency.
