The District Administrator or his/her designee has the authority to close District schools or dismiss students and/or staff early for emergencies that threaten health or safety. The decision to close schools will be based on any emergency conditions that would pose an imminent threat to the life, health, or safety of those in attendance.

Students, parents/guardians, and staff shall be informed early in each school year of the procedures that shall be used for notification of emergency closings. Staff members shall comply with the Administrative Regulation/CBA policy on reporting for work.
