The District recognizes that procedures for the safety of students and staff during tornadoes should be established.

The building principal, in conjunction with the Director of Administrative Services, shall develop a tornado emergency plan for their building that includes warning signals, safe locations, protective procedures, periodic tornado drills, and responsibilities of school employees for students. In the event of a tornado warning, the building principal shall implement the plan to provide safe shelter in the school buildings for students and staff.

The principal shall maintain a building log for tornado drills.
