1. To develop budgets and guide expenditures through advanced planning to achieve the highest quality for the educational dollars spent.
2. To explore all practical and legal sources of dollar income.
3. To establish maximum efficiency in procedures for accounting, reporting, procurement, payroll, payment of vendors and contractors, and all other areas of fiscal management.
4. To adhere to appropriate auditing, legal, and ethical standards in all areas of fiscal management.
