The District may charge student fees and/or charges for certain activities, courses and services that may require additional funding and assess fines when school property is damaged or lost.

The District believes that all student fees, fines and charges should be collectible to the extent possible. It also understands that some parents/guardians may need time to make payment of these obligations. At the discretion of the building principal, fees may be waived for student whose family income would qualify for free lunch under federal school lunch program guidelines.

Student fees, fines and charges shall be collected and recorded in accordance with established procedures.

When a fine has been charged for the loss of school property, fines will be reversed if the lost property is recovered and returned within six months. The unpaid fine will be removed from the student's balance, credited towards other outstanding fees, or transferred to the family lunch account.
