According to Aaron Zutz, Project Manager for the **DAHS STEM project**, the addition is really beginning to take shape.



"Did you know?"

There are approximately 2,350 cubic feet of air entrained concrete mix being used on this project. For every 1 cubic foot of air entrained concrete there are billions of microscopic air cells - that means there are over 2.35×10^{12} air cells on this project alone! The air pockets are created in a controlled and uniform distribution by using concrete admixtures, and protect the concrete from the effects of freeze-thaw cycles. The tiny air cells give water room to expand when it freezes to help relieve pressure and prevent the concrete from cracking.

Sara Michalski, Project Manager for the **Windsor Elementary School** project, provides her first update.



"Did you know?"

It is going to take 18 months to complete the new Windsor Elementary School. That is a total of 4,380 hours or work. The fastest building ever built in the world only took 48 hours. That building is 10 stories high and took a team of 200 people.



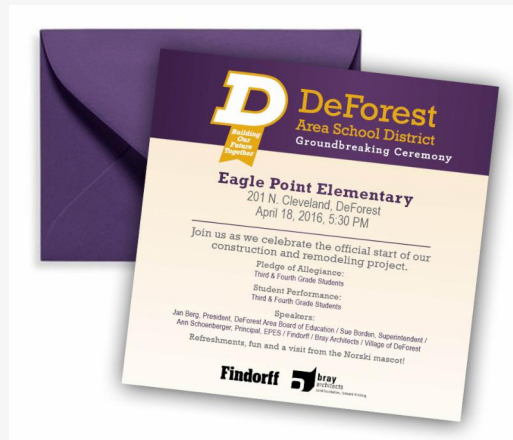
Eagle Point Elementary School groundbreaking ceremony is tonight
