The Superintendent shall not cause or allow any practice, activity, decision, or organizational circumstance which is unlawful, imprudent, immoral, or in violation of commonly accepted sound business and professional ethics, or in contravention of board policy.

Accordingly, the Superintendent may not:

- 1.1 Permit controllable financial conditions to occur which risk the fiscal integrity of the district. (**Fiscal Integrity**)
- 1.2 Provide information to the Board, Schools or community constituencies, which is knowingly untimely, inaccurate or misleading. (**Communicating Information**)
  - 1.2a Fail to provide the board with information via: documents, presentations and within conversations that will be timely, clear, concise and be formatted in a manner that reflects an understanding of adult learning and effective meeting practices.
- 1.3 Permit conflict of interest in awarding purchases or other contracts or hiring employees. (**Conflict of Interest**)
- 1.4 Allow the day to day operation of the District to prevent the achievement of the purposes and Ends of the Board. (**Effective Day-to-Day Operations**)
- 1.5 Manage the District without adequate administrative regulations. (**Administrative Regulations**)
