Board Communications Plan

The Board will develop and execute an interactive board communications plan which informs the board's Results, promotes support for district efforts, and provides for collaboration and consensus building. The plan will address:

- a) With whom the board communicates
- b) What is communicated
- c) When communication activities occur
- d) The means of communications
- e) Mechanism to evaluate the effectiveness of communication activities

Persons and subgroups to be considered will include:

- a) Citizens of the community
- b) Other school boards
- c) Other local governing bodies and community agencies
- d) The Department of Public Instruction
- e) Other relevant units of government and agencies

Board members, as part of their professional development, will receive training on effective communication skills, as necessary.
