

DASD Guiding Principles for Boundary Exceptions Relating to Employees

District elementary employees will have first priority in determining boundary exceptions. Highest priority will be for those requesting a boundary exception into their assigned building. Next priority will be for those employees who request a boundary exception into a school in which they are not employed. All outside boundary exceptions will be considered following those for employees. Any boundary exception may be denied if it will negatively impact students based on an unreasonable imbalance of class sizes throughout the District. Additional considerations that may lead to denial are effective use of building space and district wide staffing levels.
