DeForest Area School District Board of Education Meeting Minutes Monday, December 10, 2018 – 6:00 pm.

1. Convene

President Jan Berg called the December 18, 2018 regular meeting of the DeForest Area School District's Board of Education to order at 6:00 p.m.

Eric Runez verified that the meeting was properly noticed.

Keri Brunelle recited the DeForest Area School District's Mission and Vision Statements.

2. Approval of the Agenda

On a motion by Lovick, seconded by Leonhart, and passed unanimously by voice vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Board Business & possible Board action

A. Presentation of 2017-2018 District Financial Audit - Kathleen Davis, Director of Business & Auxiliary Services

<u>Discussion</u>: Director of Business & Auxiliary Services, Kathleen Davis reported on the results of the 2017-2018 District Financial Audit. She highlighted the audit findings, as well as the management discussion and analysis provided by the audit firm of Johnson Block. Areas of potential growth were found in creating further segregation of duties, and ensuring bank deposit levels are insured. Overall, the auditors reported favorable results and found no instances of noncompliance or other matters that are required to be reported under Government Auditing Standards.

B. Presentation and possible approval of OE-6 Financial Administration Board Policy Monitoring Report - Kathleen Davis, Director of Business & Auxiliary Services

<u>Discussion</u>: Director of Business & Auxiliary Services, Kathleen Davis presented the monitoring report for Board Policy, OE-6, Financial Administration, as in compliance.

On a motion by Tenpas, seconded by Statz, the DeForest Area School District Board of Education voted to accept the OE-6 Financial Administration Board Policy Monitoring Report, as presented. The motion passed with a unanimous voice vote.

On a motion by Miller, seconded by Esser, the DeForest Area School District Board of Education voted to approve the OE-6 Financial Administration Board Policy Monitoring Report, as presented, and as being in compliance. The motion passed with a unanimous voice vote.

Summary Statement:

The Board accepted the OE-6 monitoring report as presented by the Superintendent and Administration. The report was found to reflect compliance and acknowledges the auditor's findings and suggestions that the district either prepares their own or hire an independent firm to prepare the financial report, instead of the current practice of the auditor preparing it. The Board accepted the administration's response that the current practice is acceptable and appropriate, but not the auditor's preference. The Board acknowledges that the measurements and indicators for OE-6 seem to be appropriate and helpful.
