

Policy Type: Operational Expectations

Instructional Program

The Superintendent shall maintain a program of instruction that offers challenging and relevant opportunities for all students to achieve at levels defined in the Board's **Results** policies.

The Superintendent will:

1. Ensure that instructional programs are based on a comprehensive and objective review of best practices research.
2. Align curriculum with district academic standards that meet or exceed state and/or nationally-recognized model standards.
3. Effectively measure each student's progress toward achieving or exceeding the standards.
4. Ensure that the instructional program includes opportunities for students to develop talents and interests in their specialized areas of interest.
5. Ensure that the instructional program differentiates instruction to meet the needs of students of various backgrounds and abilities.
6. Encourage new and innovative practices.
7. Regularly evaluate and modify all instructional programs as necessary to assure their continuing effectiveness.
