<u>Gradebook:</u> All district teaching staff have their gradebooks on-line for parents and students to view. To see the detail of any grade, click on the bluecolored grade, and 'Show all Events' and you will see the assignments that makes up the grade being reported. The gradebook also provides information on assignments and missing assignments.

Attendance: Attendance is "real time", i.e., as it is posted by a teacher or by the office. Attendance is coded for excused and unexcused absences and tardiness. High school and middle school attendance is taken by the hour. Elementary attendance is taken twice per day in the a.m. and p.m.

Schedule: Clicking on this link will reveal the student's courses and teachers. Teachers' names are in blue indicating a link. This is a quick and easy way for parents/students to communicate with teachers.

E-Mail Notifications: Use this link if you would like to be notified by automatic email when the lunch account balance is \$8.00 or less, and/or if there is an attendance event.

Online Registration: Registering your student for the next school year is now done all online. It opens in mid-July and closes end of August. Computers and help are available at our on-site registration held in August at the high school.

Take time to navigate around in the other links to discover additional features of Family Access.

There is also a Skyward Student Mobile App. Go to the Play Store (Android) or App Store for iPhone.

Tips for Using Family Access™ Gradebook

DASD's goal is to improve communication in grading and reporting so that both have a positive, supportive impact on student learning. Information provided to parents helps them be well-informed participants in their children's education.

- Please check grades once a week. This will give teachers time to assess student work, help absent students, and do their record-keeping. Larger projects and/or English papers may take more time to grade.
- 4K, Kindergarten 3rd grade teachers enter their grades at the end of the trimester. Other teachers enter grades regularly based on the type of class and type of assignment.
- If there is a question about a missing assignment or a grade, please ask your child. You may also email the teacher any questions or concerns through the gradebook by clicking on the teacher's name.
- Teachers have been trained in analyzing student work and finding evidence of student learning. Please don't hesitate to talk with them on how grades for your child were determined.

Food Service: Parents can view the balance in their student's lunch account, payment history and student lunch purchases. Parents can also make on-line deposits to the lunch account from this link
