DAHS has a specific number of allotted tickets, so please share only with our DASD community.

How to Purchase: Use the ticket master link above, and choose “See tickets.” Look for the “Unlock” button in the upper right and enter the code, SLAM. ADA seating can be purchased through the website by selecting the ADA sections. Children two and under do not require a ticket. No tickets will be available for purchase at the door. These are the only tickets available, no other tickets will be made available to our school.

General Public Sales: Any tickets leftover from our DASD allotment will open to the general public on Wednesday, March 3rdth at 8:00 am.

Entry into Venue: All tickets will be mobile delivery so each person must purchase their own ticket. Show your ticket on your phone at the door. Doors will open for spectators 30 minutes before the scheduled game.

Seating/Social Distancing: All tickets will be sold in pods of 2-3-4 seats to allow for social distancing. All spectators must sit in their assigned seat. Everyone in attendance are required to properly wear a mask covering nose and mouth.

Championship Game Tickets: Tickets will go on sale after each of the semi-final games. You will receive a new Unlock Code when leaving the venue.

ILLEGAL ITEMS & RESTRICTIONS: The following items will not be allowed in the Menominee Nation Arena (all spectators and items are subject to search):

- Selfie Sticks
- Strollers, coolers, thermoses, bottles, cans and food and/or beverage items of any kind.

- Backpacks and any bag larger than 8.5" x 11".
- Artificial noisemakers: stadium horns, cow bells, bottles with rocks in them, thunder sticks, etc.
- Weapons of any kind. This includes pocket knives.
- Pom poms may not have sticks attached to them. Balloons, paper confetti, spray string, inflatables, etc.
- Alcohol and/or drugs.
- Large signs.(Fat heads) hand-held signs that are no larger than a piece of tag board (3'x2') that can be held by one person will be allowed. Signs may have tongue depressor sticks attached to them.
- Laptop computers are allowed.
- Laser pointers.
- NO body or face paint is allowed in the Menominee Nation Arena and no face coverings of any type are permitted.
- No paint stir sticks

In addition:

- All spectators are expected to be clothed appropriately with faces clearly visible.
- Antics involving throwing of paper airplanes or coins, etc., will result in the violator being removed from the Menominee Nation Arena.
- Fans may not leave their seats to be on the courtside area.
- Fans may not leave their seats to become involved in such things as slapping players hands during introductions, forming a tunnel for their players to run through as they enter or exit the court, etc.
- Fans may not allow others to sit on their shoulders or stand on seats or railings.
- Fans are NOT allowed on the floor of the Menominee Nation Arena following the completion of their game.

Team send off: There will be a police escort for the team on Saturday, March 6 at 8 am. They will travel from the high school along Halser Street to Hwy. V. Fans are asked to stay on the sidewalk, social distance, and wear appropriate face coverings. Parking is available in the high school parking lot and along Jefferson Street.
